## FREE C.E.R.T. TRAINING COMING TO ROLLING HILLS ESTATES

Following a major disaster, police, fire and medical professionals may not be able to fully meet the demand. Residents will have to rely on each other to meet the immediate life saving and life sustaining needs, *particularly* in isolated neighborhoods that may be cut off from main roads for a period of time.

Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) training will be taught by the Los Angeles County Sheriffs' Department. The CERT program was developed to provide basic training in safety and life saving skills for the general public. The course curriculum covers the following modules:

This training course will be presented over a two-week period as a "series" of two Tuesdays, two Wednesdays, and two Thursdays each from 6:00 pm – 9:30 pm.

All six classes must be attended in order to receive a course certificate of completion and to be certified. Students enrolled in other government sponsored CERT classes can attend any of the scheduled training modules to complete the course.
