**ARTERIAL STREET RESURFACING PROJECT**

On October 19, 2009 the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will begin resurfacing all lanes of travel on:

1. Hawthorne Boulevard from Palos Verdes Drive West to Dupre Drive , Verde Ridge Road to Indian Peak Road;
2. Palos Verdes Drive West (N / B) from Hawthorne Boulevard to North City limit ;  
and
3. Palos Verdes Drive South (E / B) from Terranea Way to Fisherman Access.

This arterial resurfacing project is funded by various grants totaling more than \$2,400,000. The roadway sections included in the project area will be resurfaced with rubberized asphalt. This material, fabricated from discarded vehicle tires, is an excellent roadway surface treatment that extends the total life of the roadway and provides a smooth driving surface which decreases vehicle noise levels. Construction is scheduled to begin October 19, 2009. All work is expected to be completed by January 2010.

The working hours for the project are 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Temporary "No Parking -Tow-Away" construction signs will be posted in the work areas during construction and access to businesses may be limited at times; however, there will always be one open lane for travel in both directions.

It is the City's goal to complete all work in the most expedient manner while maintaining a high quality of work. Your cooperation in observing all traffic controls, parking restrictions and flagmen will be appreciated.
