 Tour the tide pools teeming with fascinating marine life. Moderate.

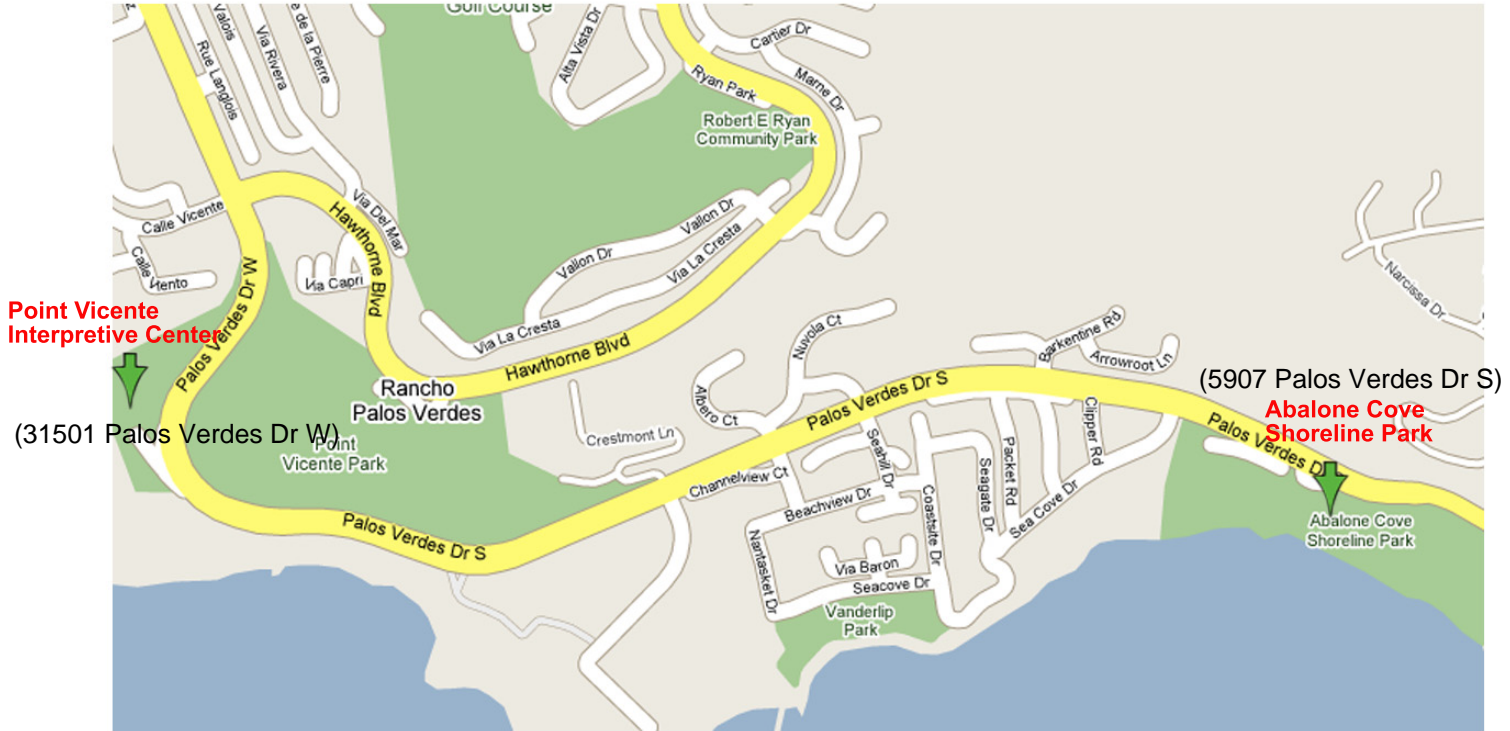
December 9 1:30 PM

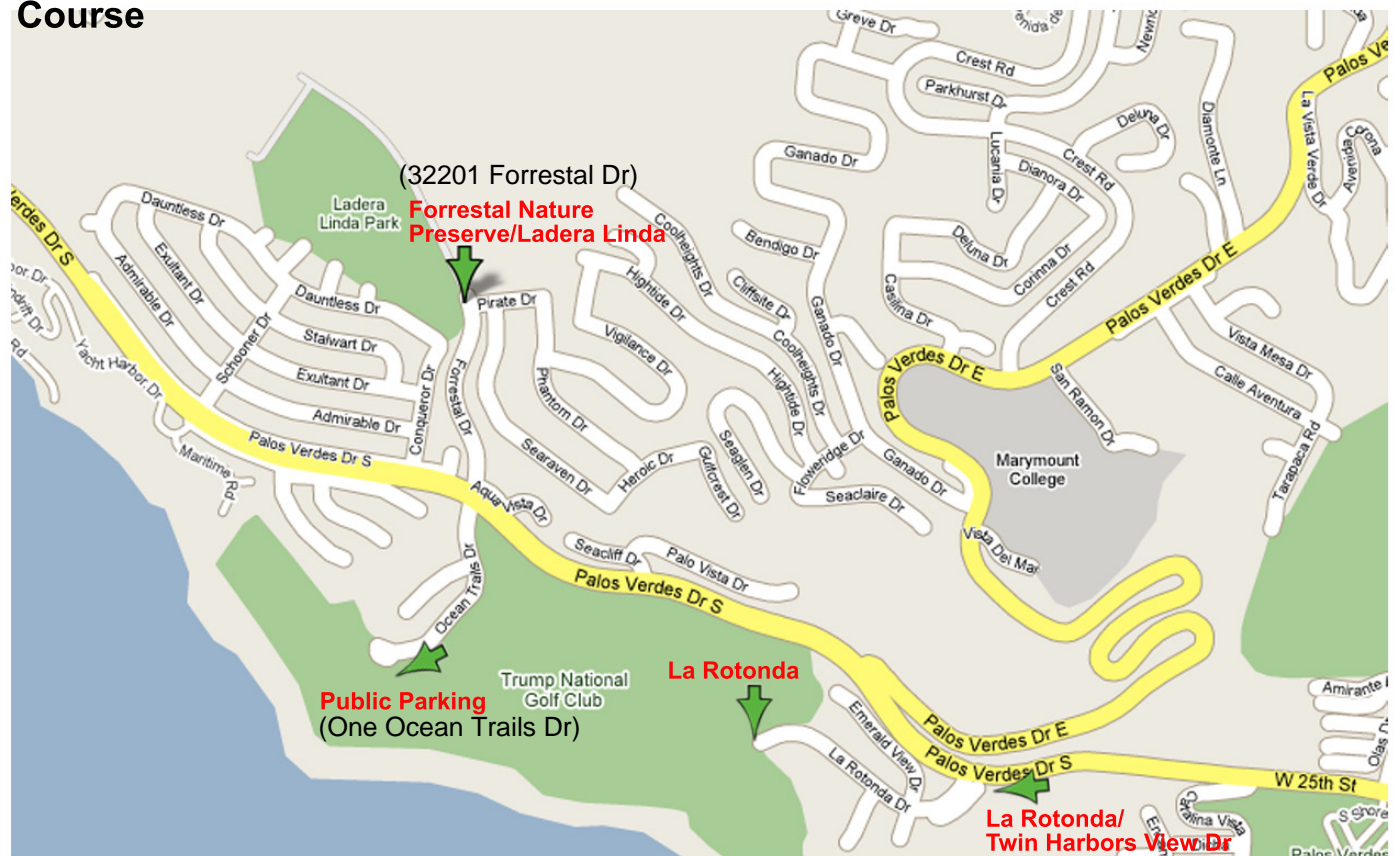
